

Domenico Scalera (*MA in Economics, University of Warwick, 1990; PH.D. in Development Economics, Università Federico II di Napoli, 1992*) is full professor in Economics at the Department of Law and Economics of Università del Sannio, Italy.

Former Director of the Undergraduate and Master Courses in Statistics and Financial Mathematics and member of Administration Board at Università del Sannio, he is currently President of AISRe (Italian Regional Science Association) and member of ERSAC (European Regional Science Association Council). His main research interests are in the field of regional economics and industrial organization. He published about 90 scientific articles in national and international journals.
